

## **Why Won't It Bloom? Class time- about 50 minutes**

Frustrated by a seemingly healthy orchid plant that won't to bloom? Orchids can grow very well in the home, but you have to treat them a bit differently than other house plants. There isn't simple answer as to why there are no flowers. Most of the time, the appearance of the plant will tell you what is wrong. For example, if the leaves are too green, you are either not giving it enough light, or you are giving too much fertilizer. If the new leaves are smaller than the old, then the plant may not be getting enough water on a regular basis. The goal of this class is to show you how to read your orchid and make the necessary changes that will produce blooms. Please bring problem plants for us to discuss.
